

A Bit of Irish History

The Four Provinces of Ireland

The four provinces of Ireland are Connacht, Leinster, Munster, and Ulster. These provinces were originally kingdoms, and the number of provinces and their boundaries changed until 1610. Today, the provinces are historical and cultural entities, and no longer serve political or administrative purposes.

A Short Prehistory

The earliest recorded mention of the major division of Ireland is in the Ulster Cycle of legends, such as the *Táin Bó Cúailnge*. The *Táin* is set during the reign of *Conchobar Mac Nessa*, king of Ulster, and is believed to have happened in the 1st century. In this period Ireland is said to have been divided into five independent over-kingdoms, or *cuigeadh* whose *rí* (kings) were of equal rank, not subject to a central monarchy. Pseudo-historians called this era *Aimser na Coicedach*, which has been translated as: "Time of the Pentarchs"; "Time of the Five Fifths"; and "Time of the provincial kings". It was also

- The most populated province

described as "the Pentarchy"

Home to many examples of medieval, Norman, Georgian, and Neolithic architecture

Munster

Located in the southwest of Ireland

A Bit of Irish History (cont)

- The largest province in terms of area
- The birthplace of modern Gaelic games, such as hurling and rugby

The chief city is Cork

Ulster

- Located in the north of Ireland
- Includes the six counties of Northern Ireland and three counties in Ireland
- The chief city is Belfast

Home to the Giant's Causeway, where basalt columns rise from the sea

Connacht

Located in the west of Ireland and includes five counties. The chief city is Galway.


